CONTINUING YOUR JOURNEY

Leaflets with 2012 dates have been reported for Charing Cross and Embankment (TFL24825.08.12), Elephant & Castle (TFL24826.08.12), Hammersmith (TFL24829.08.12), King's Cross St Pancras (TFL24832.08.12), North Greenwich (TFL24837.08.12), Piccadilly Circus (TFL24838.08.12), South Kensington (TFL24841.08.12), St. Paul's (TFL24842.08.12) and Waterloo (TFL24844.08.12). All the above replace earlier issues with a magenta Olympics stripe, and are A5 (x2).

CYCLING

"Love your bike – Leave it locked with us" – introducing the London Bridge Cycle Park, a TfL sponsored staffed facility to park bikes indoors with changing rooms, a maintenance area and a bike shop next door, charges apply, printed on a folded padlock-silhouette shaped card.

DLR – SERVICE DISRUPTIONS

"Planned works on DLR Saturday 29 & Sunday 30 September 2012" – services suspended Bank/Tower Gateway – Poplar/West India Quay, A5.

FARES & TICKETING

"Getting around with the Bus & Tram Discount scheme (JSA)" – Londoners on Jobseeker's Allowance are entitled to half adult-rate fares on buses and trams, details and tear-off application form, 1/3 A4 (x7).

LONDON OVERGROUND

"Continuing your journey to Stratford" – travel guides for the Olympic and Paralympic periods from London Overground stations by bus, Underground, NR train or on foot, issues recorded for Acton Central, Brondesbury, Brondesbury Park, Caledonian Road & Barnsbury, Crystal Palace, Dalston Junction, Dalston Kingsland, Finchley Road & Frognal, Forest Hill, Gospel Oak, Hackney Central, Hampstead Heath, Homerton, Honour Oak Park, Kensal Rise, Kentish Town West, New Cross Gate, Norwood Junction, Penge West, Rotherhithe, Shadwell, Shoreditch High Street, South Acton, Surrey Quays, Wapping, West Croydon and West Hampstead. All are 1/3 A4 (x3).

"Continuing your journey to Stratford or Earls Court" – very similar to the above but with travel options to either destination, issues recorded for Kensington (Olympia), Shepherd's Bush and Willesden Junction. All are 1/3 A4 (x4). *Copies almost certainly exist for LO stations not listed above but have not been seen.*

"London Overground timetable (1) Richmond/Clapham Junction to Stratford" – flashed as "new timetable" 16 September to 8 December 2012, 1/3 A4, 36pp. New timetables have not issued for the sections (2), (3) and (4).

LUL – ENGINEERING WORKS – SERVICE DISRUPTIONS

"Closure of Hainault loop service for upgrade work" – Wednesday 24 to Friday 26 October and Monday 29 October to Friday 2 November no service between Grange Hill and Newbury Park, Saturday and Sunday 27/28 October and 3 & 4 November no service between Woodford and Leytonstone via Newbury Park, 1/3 A4 (x4).

"Reduced escalator service at Baker Street station" – from Monday 29 October 2012 to early March 2013 no escalator service to or from the Bakerloo and Jubilee Line ticket hall, 1/3 A4 (x4).

TOURIST INFORMATION

"Free Map & Guide to London" – not sufficiently LUL/TfL orientated for usual inclusion in these pages but this leaflet from Terravision (who run coach services between Stanstead Airport and London, and who, in conjunction with a west London language school, produced their own licensed version of the Underground map in 2009) contains an extraordinarily eclectic list of tourist venues, together with a rather fussy street map, a full standard Underground map and advertisements, A5 (x4x2).

TRAMLINK

"User Guide August 2012" – following the introduction of six new trams, Line 4 runs between Elmers End and Therapia Lane, increasing capacity on the busiest sections of the network, A5, 16pp.

TRAIN TIMES

“Changes to Amersham, Chesham and Watford branches during the Paralympics” – on the Metropolitan Line minor changes to service including late evening trains to and from central London every day (29 August – 9 September 2012) and earlier trains to central London on Sundays, format similar to the leaflet previously reported for Olympic Games, $\frac{1}{3}$ A4.

“Tube guide including Chiltern Railways from Sunday 7 October to Saturday 8 December 2012 inclusive” – Metropolitan Line services to Amersham and Chesham (leaf-fall season), $\frac{1}{3}$ A4, 28pp.
