

# PLANNED ENGINEERING WORK AND STATION CLOSURES FROM 29 APRIL TO 31 MAY 2013

## STATION CLOSURES:

- **Edgware Road** (Bakerloo Line) closed for lift replacement work from Saturday 25 May 2013.
- Saturday/Sunday 4/5 May 2013, Central Line non-stopping **Mile End** because of adjacent District Line work. (District and H&C suspended for weekend engineering work). *The Central Line was scheduled to non-stop on Bank Holiday Monday also but work was completed early enabling the station to open for the Central Line on this day.*

## SUSPENSIONS

Saturday to Monday 4-6 May 2013, **Metropolitan Line** suspended Wembley Park – Uxbridge/Northwood for track replacement Northwick Park. Enhanced **Piccadilly Line** service to Uxbridge. 18 trains instead of 35 Metropolitan Line, 67 trains instead of 69 (Saturday) and 68 (Sunday) Piccadilly Line. *Replacement buses:*

- *Wembley Park – Rayners Lane all stations plus North Harrow.*
- *Wembley Park – Harrow-on-the-Hill and all stations to Northwood plus West Harrow.*

Saturday to Monday 4-6 May 2013, **District Line** suspended Tower Hill – West Ham, **Hammersmith & City Line** suspended east of Moorgate, **Circle Line** reverts to 'all round' operation, for track replacement Aldgate East and Crossrail work at Whitechapel. 46 trains instead of 61 (Saturday) and 58 (Sunday) District Line, 21 trains instead of 30 C&H. *Replacement buses:*

- *Tower Hill – Bromley-by-Bow all stations then Canning Town.*
- *Tower Hill – Bow Road all stations then Stratford.*

Saturday to Monday 4-6 May 2013, **Northern Line** suspended north of Hampstead for track replacement Brent Cross. 48 trains instead of 72. *Replacement buses:*

- *Canons Park – Edgware – Hendon Central all stations then Golders Green – Chalk Farm all stations.*
- *Hendon Central – Chalk Farm all stations.*

Saturday & Sunday 11/12 May 2013, **Central Line** suspended Liverpool Street – Hainault via Newbury Park for track replacement at Leyton. 33 trains instead of 67 (Saturday) and 34 instead of 58 (Sunday). *Replacement buses:*

- *Hainault – Newbury Park all stations plus Fullwell Cross and Ilford.*
- *Newbury Park – Wanstead all stations – Snaresbrook – Walthamstow Central.*
- *Stratford – Leyton – Leytonstone – Snaresbrook.*
- *Leytonstone – Stratford.*

Saturday & Sunday 11/12 May 2013, **Northern Line** suspended Camden Town – High Barnet and Mill Hill East for line upgrade. 48 trains instead of 72. *Replacement buses:*

- *High Barnet – Finchley Central all stations then Golders Green.*
- *Finchley Central – Camden Town all stations.*
- *Mill Hill East – Finchley Central.*

Sunday 12 May 2013, **Bakerloo Line** suspended north of Stonebridge Park for Network Rail engineering. 20 trains instead of 27. *Replacement buses: Stonebridge Park – Harrow & Wealdstone all stations.*

Sunday 12 May 2013, **Metropolitan Line** suspended Baker Street – Aldgate, **Hammersmith & City Line** suspended east of King's Cross and **Circle Line** operates Moorgate – Edgware Road via Victoria, for Thameslink and Crossrail work at Farringdon. 29 trains instead of 35 Metropolitan Line, 20 trains instead of 30 C&H.

Saturday & Sunday 18/19 May 2013, **District Line** suspended west of West Kensington and **Piccadilly Line** suspended Barons Court – Northfields/Uxbridge, for track replacement at Stamford Brook and Ealing Common, and drainage work at Hammersmith. 41 trains instead of 61 (Saturday), 58 (Sunday) District Line, 44 trains instead of 69 (Saturday), 68 (Sunday) Piccadilly Line. *Replacement buses:*

- *Earl's Court – Hammersmith and all stations to Ealing Broadway, plus Gunnersbury, – Northfields.*
- *Ealing Broadway – Boston Manor.*
- *Earl's Court – Boston Manor.*
- *Earl's Court – Richmond all stations except Barons Court but plus Chiswick Park.*

▪ *Acton Town – Rayners Lane all stations, except Park Royal but plus Hanger Lane.*

Saturday – Monday 25-27 May 2013, **Central Line** suspended North Acton – West Ruislip for track replacement and drainage work Hanger Lane – Northolt. 53 trains instead of 67 (Saturday) and 47 instead of 58 (Sunday). *Replacement buses: North Acton – West Ruislip all stations plus Park Royal.*

Saturday – Monday 25-27 May 2013, **Northern Line** suspended north of Colindale for signalling upgrade at Edgware. 59 trains instead of 72. *Replacement buses: Colindale – Burnt Oak – Edgware – Canons Park.*
